

Your .cat file will not open if you double click it on your IBM-compatible machine, what do you do?

If this is not an option, then try the following and your problem will be solved. The problem is that Microsoft chose the suffix .cat for Security Catalogue files, not knowing that Casio had chosen it for their program and data files.

Open **My Computer**

Go to the **View** menu and select **Folder Options**

Click the **File Type** tab

Find the **Security Catalogue** option, highlight it and click **Edit...**

Change the **Description** to Fa-123

Under **Action**, highlight **open**

Click **Edit...**

Now click **Browse** and find the **FA-123.EXE** file on your computer, the file pathway is likely to be

**c:\Fa123\FA123.EXE**

Click **Change Icon** and select the icon of your choice

Click **OK** and then **OK** again

You should be done now, if not contact us for help, or buy a Mac!
